Introduction

The Sharjah Economic Development Department issued "Sharjah Industrial Guide" in 2019 to complement and implement its strategic plan for planning and leading comprehensive economic development in Sharjah; enhancing services provided to clients and strategic partners; developing the industrial sector; and consolidating its processes by utilizing Sharjah's industrial base - which is the largest in the country and the region as a whole.

The Sharjah Industrial Guide is a clear and specific guide and identification tool describing Sharjah's services and procedures. The identification and documentation of services is the first building block of continuous improvement through which implemented processes and procedures are reviewed in light of the Department's vision of comprehensive development to achieve a competitive, diversified, knowledge-based and innovative economy.

This updated version of the Sharjah Industrial Guide was prepared in cooperation and coordination with strategic partners and stakeholders to update main procedures and provide a complete database capturing all information and data related to the sector, including partners and investment opportunities in Sharjah. This helps investors establish industrial partnerships that serve shared goals and add value to Sharjah's industrial sector, creating an empowering business environment that ensures economic welfare in the Emirate.

Sharjah features one of the largest spaces dedicated for industry in the UAE, including ... an industrial zone in addition to several free zones which helped the Emirate become the heart of industry in the country. Furthermore, Sharjah established a strong and empowering legislative and regulatory ecosystem that supports future plans and visions of the industrial sector and keeps abreast with the fourth industrial revolution. This was done by in implementation of the government's plans to transform the country into a leading global model in proactively addressing the challenges of the industrial future.



Overview of the Industrial Sector

Industry in Sharjah has a long history. In the past, the Emirate hosted light industries, and its people practiced some traditional professions such as building ships and fishing tools to meet their daily livelihood and sustenance needs. The industrial sector in Sharjah has flourished since the discovery of oil and the establishment of the UAE, bringing about paradigm shifts in the sector and reinforcing the scientific and practical concepts of industrial development and progress. Sharjah has become a leading industrial platform in the region, as it established in the seventies the first planned and specialized industrial zones supported by a package of services and facilities for investors in addition to infrastructure projects. This attracted more investments and stimulated economic growth, achieving the wise economic vision of His Highness Sheikh Dr. Sultan bin Muhammad Al Qasimi, Member of the Supreme Council and Ruler of Sharjah.

In a few years, Sharjah managed to attract numerous local, regional and international investments and took leading positions at the national level in terms of the number of industrial establishments, with the number of industrial licenses reaching 2,804 in 2023, at a 10% growth rate.

The industrial sector in Sharjah is reinforced by competitive and sustainable economic growth thanks to the important components available for industrial development, including capital, raw materials and labor, in addition to residential, social and security services.

The industrial sector makes significant contributions to wages and various compensations for workers, which were estimated at AED 6.2 billion in 2023. These compensations have increased by 9% in 2023 compared to 2022, which indicates the continued and consistent growth in this sector and in Sharjah's economy at large. Sharjah has also achieved great economic diversity, especially in the industrial sector, through a typical and standard weight of industrial output in the GDP, which amounted to 16.7% of the general output for the year 2023, representing the most important relative weight in the total output of factories in the country. Industrial production in the Emirate of Sharjah is also a point of strength, as the value of industrial production increased from AED 61 billion in 2022 to AED 65.6 billion in 2023, with a relative weight of 24.6%.

Furthermore, Sharjah recorded distinguished results in the formation of fixed capital in the Emirate, which increased from AED 2.5 billion in 2022 to AED 2.9 billion in 2023, which is undoubtedly a record percentage and an important indicator that the economy operates in a healthy manner and enjoys a stable attractive environment.

In April 1981, His Highness Sheikh Dr. Sultan bin Muhammed Al Qasimi, Supreme Council Member and Ruler of Sharjah, issued Emiri Decree No. 18 to establish the Economic Department. Thus, the first local economic department in the history of the United Arab Emirates was established in the Emirate of Sharjah. This Department was responsible to take over the local authority for the application of federal laws related to economic issues.

SEDD was established to prepare and implement economic plans in Sharjah, provide suitable economic environment, offer license for economic activities, monitor the application of economic performance and improve investment climate.

- Names that conflict with trademarks registered in the country unless the applicant is authorized to use them.
- Names that conflict with public order and morality in the country.
- Names that are vague, similar to registered names or may mislead the public.

Using or selecting names of important landmarks in UAE is not allowed: for example: (UAE, Abu Dhabi, Dubai, Sharjah, Ajman, Umm Al Quwain, Ras Al Khaimah, Fujairah, Burj Khalifa, Zabeel, Al Wasl). Also, they may not be chosen even if associated with (city or village).

The following names cannot be chosen:

Olympic - Union - Zulal- Numbers - Letters.

Requirements for **Environmental Activities**



Requirements / Conditions

- Obtaining environmental permit and renew it periodically
- Commitment to use cleaner and environmentally friendly fuels.
- Floor should be stable, non-slip and can bear heavy weights. It should be also lined with leakproof concrete layer
- Commitment to arrange, clean and sort the materials in the work areas. Also, waste containers should be provided and they should be emptied regularly
- Commitment to provide lighting in all sites and facilities of the establishment
- Commitment to ventilate the facility in closed working areas with the provision of hoods and chimneys with suitable filters
- Commitment to the provision of occupational safety and prevention tools that commensurate with the type of activity and the number of employees
- Provision of appropriate and separate lockers according to quality of stored material and degree of dangerousness is a must. Also, storage of high-risk materials is prohibi
- Commitment to all safety and prevention procedures related to storage operations, loading and unloading mechanism, as well as placement of guidance panels is a must
- Commitment to environmental recommendations and observations applied in the establishments inspection and follow-up record
- Commitment to requirements of storing raw chemicals involved in the industry of unbreakable containers that prevents leakage and easily opened in a must
- Provision of first-aid kit which components proportional to the activity as well as number of workers is a must. It should be placed in a clean, visible and dry place
- Commitment to proper disposal of waste according to the environmental requirements including laboratory procedures, retention of records and laboratory reports.
- Provision of dye chambers is a must according to the environmental requirements. These chambers should be equipped with filtration tools for the resulting pollutants
- Develop a maintenance program for all tools and equipment used in work.
- Provision of smelter and furnace conforming to the environmental requirements that are tightly sealed and contain a ventilation and filtration system is a must
- The obligation to monitor air pollutants periodically resulting from the exercise of activity according to environmental requirements
- Obtaining generator permit in case of suing generator is a must

- Renewal of environmental permit annually from the of Environmental Control Department is a must.
- A generator permit must be obtained from the Environmental Control Department.
- Dye industry activity.
- Smelting activity.









Tools and Equipment Health Requirements

Tools and equipment should have the following conditions:



Materials

- All surfaces touching food should be should be non-toxic and do not produce odor, color, or taste that is unacceptable, corrosion resistant, washable, repeated, smooth, free of holes, cracks, paint, and are not affected by food or absorbent unless the nature of work requires certain surfaces such as wood.
- ▶ Do not use galvanized iron in food contact surfaces in food processing devices.
- Castings containing lead, antimony or cadmium flakes should not be used in food contact surfaces in food processing devices.
- To wear the equipment made of copper or tin alloys so that the food does not contact with copper directly.
- The plastic or glass used in the food processing machinery should be scratch resistant and should not contain phenols or free formaldehyde or any substances that affect the properties of the food that it is in contact with.
- ▶ Steam boilers and packing materials shall be non-porous and non-absorbent and shall not react with the product and the connections between the boilers shall allow the cleaning process.
- Conveyor belts used in food factories should be made of a material that is easy to clean and does not allow the absorption of food juices.



Health Design

- ► The devices and tools should be designed and installed in a manner that prevents health damage and allows easy cleaning and sterilization
- Prevention and industrial security methods should be available in sharp-edged instruments and tools
- Do not puncture or condense over manufacturing lines



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Health design of buildings

The design of the food plant should include:



Site

The plant should be away from bad odors, smoke, dust and other contaminants and be in an area not exposed to water immersion, whatever its source.



size

► The building should be large enough to meet the purpose for which the equipment, persons or materials are contended, should be included in warehouses sufficiently large to store raw materials and finished products.



Roads and areas

The roads and areas that serve the factory and within which it is located should be suitable for the traffic of vehicles



design:

The proposed design allows easy maintenance, adequate hygiene, and proper health monitoring throughout the production stages:

- ► The building should be intact
- ► The design of the building should not allow entry and harbor of pests, insects, birds and environmental pollutants such as smoke and dust
- ► The design of the plant should lead to the application of sanitary methods to the regular flow in the manufacturing lines from the arrival of raw materials to the final product and lead to the provision of vital conditions suitable for industry

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Floors:

They should be made from water-proof and non-absorbent materials. They should also be easy to wash and clean, non-slip, non-toxic, free from cracks and drilling and not affected by weak acids, alkali and steam. The floors should be tilted to place sewage



Walls:

- They should be made from insulating bricks, and should be soft, waterproof, non-absorbent, washable and easy to clean.
- Also, they should be preferably painted with a light, harmless paint to distinguish the dirt and be free of cracks



Roofs:

► They should be made in a way that prevent prevents accumulation of dirt, condensation and fungus growth and should be easy to clean



Stairs, lifts and additional fixtures (eg. pavements, escalators and slopes)

lt is designed or installed in a manner that does not cause food contamination and can be easily cleaned



Doors

▶ They should be smooth, non-absorbent and close automatically



Windows and other openings

- They should be designed to prevent dirt accumulation. Also, they should be provided with a suitable mesh wire to "prevent the entry of insects, flies and rodents" that is made from a stainless material and designed in such a way that it is easy to clean and maintain.
- Likely, the surface should be smooth and non-absorbent and the inner side of the windows, if any, should be tilted to prevent it from being used as shelves as well as windows should be closed tightly.



Ventilation

The building should be provided with appropriate ventilation to prevent high heat, to prevent condensation of steam and dust, and to remove polluted air. Also, it should prevent air to move from contaminated areas to clean areas and production rooms should be supplied with internal ventilation too.



Lighting

The natural or industrial lighting should be sufficient so as not to cause inaccuracies of the color identification. Also, lighting bulbs should be installed and suspended above the production lines at any stage of the production of the safe type and should be stored in a manner to prevent contamination of food if broken and should not produce shadows or intense gloss



Changing and Shower Rooms

- Changing Rooms: changing rooms should be provided to workers with Special lockers for keeping their clothes. Also, the working uniforms should be clean and dry.
- Nower Rooms: The staff shall have a place to shower. These places or rooms should be provided with hot and cold water in suitable quantities. These rooms shall not be open directly to the food handling facilities, and shall always be clean and equipped with the appropriate cleaning materials. Likely, such rooms should be painted with harmless paint, with light color and should be without cracks.
- In addition, the number of shower rooms shall not be less than the following:

Number of shower rooms	Number of staff
2	from 1 to 10
4	from 11 to 20
6	from 21 to 40
8	from 41 to 60
10	from 61 to 80
12	from 81 to 100
A shower room for 10 additional people	more than 100



Toilets

- Toilets shall be designed in a manner that facilitates the disposal of waste in a hygienic method; provided with automatically-closing doors; well-lit and ventilated; not open directly to food-handling areas; always be clean; and provided with a siphon, appropriate heating and cooling facilities, and hand washbasins and hand drying equipment.
- ► Instructions for alerting staffs to wash their hands with liquid soap and disinfectants after using the toilet shall be plastered.
- The number of toilets shall not be less than the following:

Number of people in the shift	Number of toilets	Number of hand washbasins
from 1 to 10	2	2
from 11 to 20	4	4
from 21 to 40	6	6
from 41 to 60	8	8
from 61 to 80	10	10
from 81 to 100	12	12
more than 100	toilets for 10 additional people	hand washbasins for 10 additional people

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Toilets:

- The toilets should be designed to facilitate the disposal of waste in a healthy manner. Also, they should be provided with self-closing doors with good lighting and ventilation. Likely, they should not be open directly to food handling facilities. In addition, they should be kept clean and supplied with siphon, the proper heating and cooling equipment, and the hand-dryer equipment.
- Instructions should be issued to alert workers to wash their hands with liquid soap and disinfectants after using the toilet.
- Therefore, the number of toilets should not be less than the following:



Sinks:

- ▶ That workers have adequate and appropriate equipment to wash their hands and dry them in any place that requires their existence.
- Also, they should be placed in clear places and to be always kept in a healthy condition and preferably for disposable towels.



Disposal of waste

► The waste should be disposed of in a manner that does not allow the contamination of sources of potable water and food. Also, The means of disposal of waste shall be approved by the competent official health authorities. Likely, they should be be covered in a manner that prevents odors, pests and insects.



Water sources

Drinkable water

To be available in sufficient quantity with the appropriate protection from the pollution factors and to be consistent with what is stated in the Gulf standard of «bottled water». Also, it is preferable to use disposal drinking cups.

Non-drinkable water

▶ Must be in accordance with the health requirements approved by the health authorities and free of microbiological contamination factors, including no more than 4 per 100 ml of colon bacteria.



Tools for collecting and disposing damaged materials and food:

To provide the necessary sanitary means for the collection and transport of damaged materials and food outside the factory in the places designated for disposal.



Health requirements during manufacturing The following should be taken into account during the manufacturing process:



Trading of Raw Material:

- ▶ Do not accept raw material that already contains toxic or exotic decomposition products that can not be removed to the acceptable extent by normal sorting, processing or manufacturing processes
- The raw materials should be stored in the factory under conditions that protect them from pollution, insect infestation and corruption. Also, the warehouses, doors and windows shall be designed to prevent the entry of insect pests and rodents. However if rodents appeared, the stores must be evacuated and disinfected so that they are free from rodents and then provided with lockers to prevent them from entering again.
- ► The water used in the transport of raw materials shall be in accordance with the Gulf Standard for "bottled water". Likely, The sea water used for transporting fish or marine products to the plant shall not be used without the permission of the competent official health authorities and should be subjected to periodic inspection as required.



Inspecting and Sorting:

The chosen material should be checked before manufacturing in a suitable location within it to remove the inappropriate materials and to conduct these processes in a clean and healthy ways. Such thing will help the following manufacturing processes to have clean raw materials.



Washing or other preparation processes:

Washing the raw materials if necessary to remove dust and other contaminants. The used water in the washing process should not be used again unless if treated so that it will not threat the public health.

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Preparation and manufacturing

The timing of the preparation process until the final product and the packaging process should be carried out quickly and continuously. Such process should be done under conditions that prevent the product from being contaminated. corrupt and damaged. Likely, such conditions should prevent the growth of microorganisms causing disease or poisoning. In addition the process should contain the withdrawal of periodic samples from the production line and the final product in a random way to ensure the safety of the product



Methods of packing and storing the finished product

When you pack and store the product, consider the following:

- Product type.
- Ensure that the packing materials do not contain any substances that cause undesirable organic or sensory changes in the product. Also, they should be treated in a manner that does not lead to poisoning and does not affect the food that it touches.
- ▶ The packing materials shall be non-absorbent, tasteless and odorless as well as they shall ensure appropriate protection of the product from pollution.
- Packing and storing methods
- ▶ The packing process should be conduced under suitable conditions.
- Ensure that conservation methods protect the product from contamination, corruption, infection and any other hazard to public health.



Numbering Final Product:

▶ The final products that are distributed during manufacture or packing shall be numbered so that the label and the date of production can be determined to separate the food label which may be contaminated or become unsuitable for the purpose used.



Storing and Transporting Final Product:

- ▶ The storage and transport of the final product shall be carried out under conditions that prevent contamination or reproduction of microorganisms, while protecting the product against corruption or damage to containers.
- Periodic inspection of the final product shall be carried out during storage to ensure that the food is suitable for human consumption and that it conforms to the final product specifications.
- Storage rooms should be free from moisture, and should be air conditioned, cooled and equipped with rodent resistance methods. www.shjmun.gov.ae

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Staff Health Requirements:

The following considerations should be taken into account:

- Workers whom deal with food should be examined medically before being appointed by the responsible official health authorities in accordance with the requirements established by the official competent authority. Also, medical examination of the workers should be done periodically of once every year to ensure their medical safety and that they are free from epidemic diseases.
- Workers with contaminated injuries, gastrointestinal ulcers or any infectious disease should be excluded until they recover.
- Workers must bathe before and after manufacturing in food factories and should wear protective masks on mouth and nose to protect food from pollution.
- Worker's nails must be short and clean and they should wash their hands with water, soap or disinfectant before starting work. Also, they should be prevented from wearing jewelry to avoid contact with food products.
- Workers should be provided with clean clothes and should wear clean gloves that are made of impermeable material as well as clean headgear if necessary. Likely, clothes shouldn't be placed in any manufacturing rooms
- To prevent eating, drinking, spitting, picking the nose, chewing gum, using tobacco in any form during manufacturing. handling, packing and storing of products in the factory.
- During the manufacturing process, the worker shall not put his hand in their mouth, eyes, ears, and head when working. Also they should not cough or sneeze near the food.
- Workers shouldn't sleep or lie in the workplace and in food stores.
- Precautions should be taken to prevent contamination of food when having visitors.







Pest Resistance:

The following requirements should be taken into account:

- Control and disposal of external breeding sites of pests and indoor accommodation as well as subjecting winter habitat areas to periodic monitoring.
- ► Continuous inspection of floors, walls, elevators and transport equipment for the presence of insect secretions and their eggs in the cracks.
- ► The control material should be very effective for rodents and should be used in a manner that does not lead to food contamination. Also, their degree of toxicity should be low for humans and to be referred to the competent authority to determine the type of control material.
- ► Cleaning equipment and tools after use of pesticides is a must to remove the remaining materials before using again. Also, cleaning materials should be fully soluble and do not occur corrosion of metal surfaces. Likely, they should be good for decomposition or moisturizing and should have emulsifying effect and ability to dissolve solids of food residues. In addition, they should have a deadly impact on germs.
- The pesticide should be stored in a closed room and away from the manufacturing facilities. Also, it should only be used for this purpose and should be distributed and handled with a permit and for trained personnel. Likely, extreme care should be taken to avoid contamination of food.



Health Control Programs:

The following requirements should be taken into account:

- Each factory shall have a specific person who has separate production duties to take responsibility for cleaning the factory.
- ► This person should have permanent assistants and be well trained on the special cleaning machines and the installation of cleaning equipment. Also, they should be aware of the seriousness of the pollution.
- Sensitive sites, equipment and materials should be given special attention.



Laboratory Monitoring Methods:

The following requirements should be taken into account:

- ▶ There shall be a special laboratory in each factory for the necessary tests to ensure the safety of the products
- ► The official bodies are responsible for taking periodic samples of the production for analysis to ensure the safety of the product and conform to the standard specifications

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Health Training for Workers


The following requirements should be taken into account:

- Informing and educating workers about health rules that must be observed in food processing, pollution and ways to avoid them.
- ▶ Preparing programs and training courses to workers (seminars, films, lectures, posters, etc.) that show the importance of food handling in a healthy manner and the necessary precautions to prevent food contamination.
- Workers should pass the training program within the Sharjah Food Safety Program

Food Tracking and Retrieving



- ► The food establishment shall cooperate with the competent authorities in taking the necessary precautions in order to avoid or minimize the health risks of the food being supplied.
- The food establishment shall provide the supplied food with identification labels according to the laws and regulations. Such thing will help to facilitate their tracing through the process of documenting and labeling.
- ▶ The food establishment shall keep the following documents:

A. Information records of the food products supplied to the establishment stating:

- supplier name
- supplier address
- nature of imported products
- products date of receipt

B. Information records of the food products supplied from the establishment stating:

- customer name
- customer address
- nature of imported product
- products date of supply
- The food establishment shall keep such documents for the following periods of time:
- A. Six months after the expiry of food with a validity period of more than five years.
- ▶ B. Six months from the date of supplying the supplier for perishable food, which specifies its consumption period at a specified date or with a validity period of less than three months and where the food is intended for distribution to the final consumer.

C. Five years in all other cases.

- ► The food establishment should, in the event that it believes that the food imported, produced, processed, manufactured or distributed may pose a danger to human health or not conform to the requirements and standards of food safety, shall consider the following:
- Take action to retrieve food from the market
- Inform consumers of the reasons for food retrieving in a clear and precise manner
- Inform the competent authorities of the measures taken

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Requirements of General Food Control Department to prepare engineering plans for industrial food establishments

- Contracting with a food consultancy company accredited by Sharjah City Municipality
- Submitting engineering schemes drawings showing the equipment, internal distribution and dimensions of the site, approved by food consulting company in the Sharjah City Municipality.
- ► The drawings must be in accordance with the requirements of "HACCP" food safety system and the health requirements of Sharjah City Municipality which are required on site.
- ► The following requirements should be taken in consideration when submitting drawings:
- Must be colored
- Must display the movement of (workers raw materials finished product waste sewage)
- ▶ Must include type of air conditioning and ventilation used and how they should be distributed in all areas and sections of the site
- Must provide image of machines and equipment used on the site
- Must clarify the dimensions and areas of the sections
- Must display product type and explain the serial layout of the production
- Must clarify the places and streets surrounding the site
- A table should be made with the symbols and terms on the drawings
- The direction on drawings must be clear
- A side box should be provided to the right of the drawing, with the seal of the food consulting company and the credentials issued by Sharjah City Municipality
- Writing on the drawings should be in both Arabic and English
- Drawings should be submitted on A1 paper
- A coordination should be done with the Licenses Committee at the Food Control Department of Sharjah City Municipality to schedule the discussion of the drawings in the presence of the consultant from the food consulting company accredited to the municipality and site owner/ landlord

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All shipments of imported food should be submitted with original and health documents and certificates that are issued by the concerned authority at the origin country including the following:

- Customs declaration
- Delivery permission
- Health certificate
- Packing/ contents list

- ► Halal Certification for Meat, Poultry and their Products issued by Halal certificates providers.
- Certificate of Origin
- Any additional documentation may require in some special cases

Procedures:

When applying for the required documents and health certificates, the inspector should do the following:

- review the documents and health certificates for each shipment
- In the event that the inspector cannot reach all the food items in the shipment or has difficulties in detection, the shipment may be transferred for inspection in the company's warehouses in exchange for a pledge not to dispose of the shipment
- Detection / inspection of the shipment and verify the validity and conformity with technical specifications and regulations
- Sampling of laboratory tests when necessary
- ▶ The final release of the shipment in case of matching
- * Note: All imported food products must be registered in the electronic food registration program (ZAD).

- 8. Copy of conformity certificate issued by the Ministry of Industry & Advanced Technology (for certain products)

- 10. Original permit in case of renewal
- Concerned inspector should check the vehicle
- If the vehicle is identical, the permit fee is charged and fines are paid if any

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






Issuance of Food Export Certificate Procedures





- Obtain a valid health card for driver and assistant if available
- ▶ Keep a copy of the commercial license and permit inside the vehicle
- Clearly place name and address of the food establishment on the vehicle
- ▶ Never use food vehicles for transporting or distributing non-food products.
- Provide sufficient lighting for the vehicle with suitable insulation of the back glass
- ▶ The vehicle used to transport food products should be suitable for the nature of storage of the product
- Provide a thermometer for refrigerators in the vehicle cabins to monitor the temperature
- ▶ No accumulation of food inside the vehicle is a must
- ► The vehicle must be closed and covered from all sides (not exposed)
- ▶ Shelves should be provided to separate the various foodstuffs inside the vehicle
- The walls, ceilings and floors should be made of stainless material such as aluminum or stainless steel or others
- Installation of hooks and pipes of stainless material in the case of vehicles for the transport of frozen meat is a must
- Provide plastic or pneumatic curtains at the doors (in case of refrigerators) to prevent leakage of cold during unloading and loading
- ▶ Design refrigerating equipment and equipment used to cool food in a manner that prevents food contamination with the periodic detection of cooling devices to handle any possible leakage of refrigerants
- ▶ The doors should have a rubber frame to prevent cold leakage and sealing
- Medium and heavy truck are allowed for transportation only and not for distribution
- In drinking water distribution vehicles, a box with shelves of non-resistant material shall be provided for placing the containers on them
- ► The distribution of various bakery products requires the provision of plastic boxes for the preservation of products in addition to providing a closed container to put products returned from the markets
- In ice molds transportation and distribution vehicles, boxes of fiber are required to be there and should be completely isolated. Also, the the name of the institution should be written on the vehicle and that it is dedicated to the transfer and distribution of ice molds
- Fast food delivery vehicles are required to provide thermal storage boxes
- Regular maintenance, cleaning and sterilization of food distribution vehicles should be carried out with a focus on the importance of refrigerating vehicles. Transport and distribution of refrigerated and frozen food items before loading in a timely manner is important to ensure the efficiency and validity of the cooling system

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Procedures:

- ► Fill out transport validity certificate. Then, submit the application to the reception for approval, registration and provide a copy of industrial license too.
- Pay fees for issuing food export validity certificate.
- Concerned inspector should review and check required documents.
- ▶ In the event that the food products to be exported are not included in the pre-sampling program for periodic analysis and conformity in the food laboratory in Sharjah City Municipality, samples are drawn from these food products for laboratory examination.
- Issuance of an export validity certificate for the corresponding food products.

Note:

- ▶ When exporting to GCC countries, these food products must be registered by the Food Control Department at Sharjah City Municipality.
- ➤ Some countries require certain requirements for export to it. Therefore, the Food Control Department must be reviewed to make sure of obtaining such requirements.



Custom duties are imposed on imported goods at 5% of the total value of product including including shipping and insurance, unless the goods are subject to special customs duties such as tobacco products or are exempt from customs duties.

- For non-exempted goods, a duty of 5% is collected on CIF value and registration fees are collected in cash or by cheque.
- ▶ If the attached invoice is not original, an amount of AED 1,000 must be taken as a deposit until the original copy is submitted during the period specified for collecting the insurance deposit.
- ▶ If the certificate of origin is brought or a copy thereof, a deposit of AED 1,000 must be taken. The goods are therefore inspected to determine the country of origin of the goods.

Export

Exporters or agents of goods intended for export shall go to the competent Customs Department and declare them in detail. If any restricted goods are exported, the exporter must obtain the necessary approval from the competent authority and submit them to customs.

Insurance for re-exports

The insurance value shall be equal to the value of the customs duties due on the goods that will be re-exported. The guarantee can be recovered after submitting the documents proving that the goods have actually left and exported from the country. In case of not providing the required documents, it will not be possible to recover the amount.



Entry and Exit Certificate

The center checks the entry and exit certificate and makes sure that the container or goods have been entered into the port with the lead number written on the certificate and matches the number on the container. Then, this number should be written it in the customs records. In addition, a statement should be issued for the goods to ensure that the container or goods were shipped from the country's ports. Later on, the certificate should be ratified after the ship leaves to be able to recover the insurance value.



Other Required Documents

▶ VCC (Vehicle Customs Certificate) is a document for registering vehicles. No vehicle will be registered without producing the VCC.


Service Steps and Procedures

- The inspection shall be carried out according to the request of the customer. In this case, the application fee shall be paid according to the type of meter to be inspected.

- ► However, if the meter is defected, meter average consumption period of malfunction is recorded. Then, meter should be changed or re-installed after the repair and after that the request is closed.

- You must submit the application for amendment of registration within 20 business days from the date of the change in circumstances that may require an update to the tax records maintained with the FTA.
- ▶ 8. Do I need to upload supporting documents as part of the registration amendment application?
- ▶ It depends on the amendment application being submitted. For more details, please refer to the "Documents required» section in this page. Ensure that any data you type in the application is identical to the relevant supporting documents in order to avoid resubmitting your application.

9. Can I save the application as a draft to be updated later? If yes, for how long?

Yes, you can save the in-progress application as a draft and complete it at a later point in time. However, if you do not submit your application within 60 calendar days of initiating it, your application will be automatically cancelled. There will be reminder notifications sent to your registered email/verified mobile.

10. What is the estimated time to complete application review by the FTA?

▶ Generally, the estimated time to complete the

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application by the FTA is 20 business days from the date the completed application was received by the FTA. However, in case where any additional information is needed, FTA may take additional time to process the application. The applicant needs to provide the additional information and re-submit the application. It may take the FTA a further 20 business days to respond to the updated application. If the application is not resubmitted within 60 calendar days from the date you received the notification from FTA, the application shall be auto-rejected.

11. What will happen once the application is submitted to the FTA?

- a. Processing your application:
- i. Your application will now be reviewed by the FTA. If we require more information to assist with the review, we will contact you through the email. You will need to provide the information requested in order for us to continue processing your application.
- ii. Once we have completed our review, we will either approve or, in some cases, may have to reject the application. We will notify you by email of our decision.
- iii. Where we reject an application, we will provide you with the reasons for doing so. You may re-apply but only once you have resolved the matters brought to your attention.
- ▶ b. Issuance of updated CT registration certificate post Amendment
- i. Following approval of your Amendment application, your tax records will be updated. You can download the updated CT registration certificate from your EmaraTax account.

- The application status can be viewed on the applicant's dashboard in their EmaraTax account. The following provides a summary of the application statuses:
 - Drafted: You have not completed or submitted the application form

 - Approved: Your application form has been approved by the FTA and tax records successfully updated



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FAQs

- 1. Can the FTA refund payments made erroneously or in excess without submitting a refund request?
- In order to get back the payments made erroneously or in excess, a refund request must be submitted
- 2. Can the payments done erroneously or in excess be kept as credit?
- Yes, the applicant may carry-forward the payment in their FTA account as credit for the next tax periods
- 3. Will any penalties apply in cases of excess payments?

▶ No penalties are imposed for paying excess

- ▶ There are no deadlines for submitting a refund request for the excess payments
- 5. Why is the refund request taking longer than 25 working days to be processed?
- In some cases, the authority has reasonable grounds for requiring a longer period to review the refund application, and as such the FTA shall notify you.

information is required, the FTA will ask the applicant to provide additional documentation. After submitting the additional documentation, it may take the FTA a further 25 business days to respond to the updated request for a refund of payments

RUWAD provides financing programs for SME's in Sharjah to be able to develop their products and services, meeting the needs of their clients, and to stay in business and succeed. The Foundation, when providing financing services to SME's, recognizes that

sufficient financing is one of the vital elements to enable an SME to overcome the starting up and operating challenges and achieve the development, growth and excellence in providing products and services.



General requirements to benefit from the financing programs:

- ▶ If the project's foundation exceeds 3 years, kindly provide (Audited financial statements for 2 years)
- Project must be owned by UAE citizens.
- Project should be located in the Emirate of Sharjah or its affiliated cities.
- Project should be under the name of the applicant.
- Project founding date should not exceed 3 years.

- ➤ The number of licenses owned by both the applicant and the partners should not exceed five licenses.
- The participation of the project owner should not be less than 20% of the total investment costs of the project.
- To submit a complete and detailed feasibility study in addition to all required documents.



a. Direct Financing Program

- ► The funding programs of «RUWAD» Foundation include financing new and existing projects according to the terms and criteria that suit the category of the project submitted, through the direct and indirect financing programs (by banks).
- ► The Foundation finances small and medium enterprises without interest in an amount not exceeding 400.000 dirhams.



Privileges of Direct Financing Program:

- The funded project is exempt from interest, profits or bank fees.
- The project is provided with a period from paying the instalments of the finance amount of one year only, starting from the date of receiving
- the financing amount for new projects, and 6 months for existing projects.
- ► The debt should be payed within two years after the end of the provided period.



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b. Indirect Financing Program (Thru Banks)

▶ The Foundation finances enterprises in cooperation with banks (Sharjah Islamic Bank) whereas the permissible finance amount reaches 2,000,000 dirhams.



Privileges of Indirect Financing Program:

- "RUWAD" Foundation bears 25% of the total guarantees decided by the bank on the project applying for financing.
- ► The new project is provided a period of repayment for a period of one year only,
- starting from the date of receiving the financing amount. On the other hand, the existing project is provided a period of 6 months.
- ▶ The debt should be repaid within 3 to 5 years.
- ▶ Reducing profit rate of not more than 5.85%.

- Project should not be in the market for more than three years.
- Applicant (and partners) should not have more than five licenses.





Membership Program Privileges:


- ➤ The project is exempted from the fees of government agencies in the Emirate of Sharjah for a period of 3 years from the date of establishing the project. If the project is and existing one and has not completed 3 years, it is exempt from the rest of these fees. Also, exempting projects from 50% of government agency fees for an additional two years.
- Providing no less than 10% of annual purchases to federal and local government agencies for the benefit of Emirati small and medium enterprises.
- The project is exempt from all fees of awareness workshops and training programs organized by the Foundation. In addition, it is provided with a 50% discount from the fees involved in diploma and specialized programs.
- ➤ The project grants priority to participation in exhibitions and conferences organized by the Foundation, as well as exhibitions and conferences organized by government agencies according to the capabilities available.
- Ministry of Human Resources and Emiratisation: (classifying the facility as a first-class facility in an incentive program).
- Ministry of Industry and Advanced Technology

- Conformity and Standardization Services Sector: (Exemption from fees for quality mark certification).


